- We have a student at our school with a severe kiwi fruit allergy. Kiwi fruit may be sent to school, but we request that your child only eats the kiwi fruit at the
 - designated table and then washes their hands and mouth after eating.
- We are nut free in the Aroha team. Please help us keep allergic student safe by not including any nuts or nut products in your child's lunchbox.
- o Hats are compulsory in Term 1 and 4. We have a one-week grace period, following that our 'no hat no play' policy comes into effect. We have silver pens should you still be needing to name your child's hat and shoes.
 - Named water bottles need to be brought to school daily.
 - o We use Class Dojo for our digital portfolios. To receive these, you will need to sign up to ClassDojo Class Dojo. Your class teacher will provide sign up details if you have not done this already.
- o We request all toys remain at home, unless requested by a teacher.
- o Punctuality is important to us. Students arriving ten minutes before the bell have a chance to organise their belongings, socialise with their friends and parents can catch up with teachers if they need.
- o For your child's safety, we request students are dropped off after 8.30am as staff are generally in meetings until then. Students arriving after 8.50 am need to report to the Student Office for a late slip.
- o Children must be collected from the Aroha area after school by a parent/caregiver or a sibling from year 5 and above. For the safety of your children, please inform us if someone different is collecting your child from school.
- o Students are to be collected before 3.20 pm. After this time, students will be taken to the office and parents contacted.

- Please notify the school office if your child is going to be late or will be absent for the day.
- We have buses that run between school and Feilding and Ashhurst daily. Please email your child's teacher, as well as Gemma Stewart, our bus teacher, if your child is using the bus, and the days and times when this will be needed. gemmas@cornerstone.ac.nz
- Internet agreement forms need to be signed and returned as soon as possible. Students in Aroha team Reading (1) have access to Reading Eggs and Mathseeds. Please contact your child's teacher if you still require your

child's login and password or require any assistance with these.
